Overview

For the purpose of this Intellectual Output two questionnaires were designed for the two groups of participants/ users, the teachers and the students in order to collect their views and thoughts about :

- Their involvement in the project, their expectations and motivation
- the prospects opened up after their participation in the project
- the introduction of the new tool used as an alternative assessment way which moves away from the strict subject boundaries and introduces a holistic view to student evaluation..
- The aspects/ components of the portfolio and whether they were reflecting their current state
- The way the use of the NONFORLESL tool/method has helped them reflect on their views of Early School Leaving.
- The way the use of the tools contributed to the motivation of students' learning progress, their self-esteem, whether it has contributed to the improvement of their confidence and presence in school (minimize absenteeism, disruptive behaviour etc.)

The questionnaire include both open-ended questions, as well as close-ended questions and multiple-choice questions. The questionnaires will be prepared in English and then translated in the national languages of the the participating countries. The main aspects of the interviews will also be clarified.

Each partner can pilot test the questionnaire according to the participants and make necessary minor changes to fulfill the purpose of the survey.

After the completion of the survey the data collected from the questionnaire, interviews and observations will be processed and analysed in order to be used for the overall evaluation of the tool which will be used in the Overall Comparative Implementation Strategy of the NONFORLESL project.
